Catechism on Unity in Diversity

791 The body's unity does not do away with the diversity of its members: "In the building up of Christ's Body there is engaged a diversity of members and functions. There is only one Spirit who, according to his own richness and the needs of the ministries, gives his different gifts for the welfare of the Church." The unity of the Mystical Body triumphs over all human divisions: "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

1201 Through the liturgical life of a local church, Christ, the light and salvation of all peoples, is made manifest to the particular people and culture to which that Church is sent and in which she is rooted. the Church is catholic, capable of integrating into her unity, while purifying them, all the authentic riches of cultures.

Cultural Diversity in the Catholic Church in the United States

In February 2013 (revised June 2014), the Secretariat for Cultural Diversity in the Church of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops commissioned the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate at Georgetown University to estimate the size and distribution of Black/ African American, Asian American/Pacific Islander, Hispanic/Latino, and American Indian/Alaskan Native Catholic populations in the U.S., as well as the locations of Catholic parishes known to serve these communities.
